## Parish Pantry

This year at Mass, we would like to collect donations for our Parish Pantry. Our Parish Pantry makes 35 lunches a day, Monday through Friday. They need a variety of items each week. The list below is in order of priority.

Some items that you can donate are: Paper towels plastic spoons Clorox wipes paper lunch bags Ziploc sandwich bags individually wrapped sweet snacks such as HoHos, rice Crispy Treats, Twinkies, individually wrapped salty snacks such as crackers or pretzels (snack sized) fruit cups (4oz Dole four packs, etc.) **NO CANNED FRUIT** crackers jars of jelly (any variety-around 18oz) peanut butter (16oz and up) water bottles The Parish Pantry has limited refrigerator space, so they will need to purchase fresh items on a weekly basis.
